QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS LIST
2nd QUARTER - 2016

Listed below are some of the significant issues responded to by Radio Station KVNN-AM, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period April 1, 2016 to June 30, 2016. The listing is by no means exhaustive or all-inclusive. These issues were in part ascertained through discussions with service-providers and general interaction of station staff with the community, and staff knowledge of the community and area occurrences. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any particular priority.

The following issues were principal topics or themes within the station's weekly public affairs program, "Issues Today" (IT), which is broadcast on Sunday Mornings at 7:00am. Each program has a normal running time (or length) in the range of 29 to 30 minutes. Each program is usually in two or three parts, each dealing with separate topics and issues.

Environment/Water Safety – 04/03/16 – IT – Interview with Sophia Gushee, Toxicity Expert, about water toxicity in the home, and about how consumers can find out about other toxic materials in the home.

Unemployment/Foreign Trade – 04/10/16 – IT – Interview with Emily Cadei, Political Correspondent, Newsweek, about the growing opposition to international trade deals, and about the effects of jobs leaving the Midwest areas of the country.

Student Loans/Economy – 04/10/16 – IT – Interview with Bruce Mesnekoff, Author of "The Ultimate Guide to Student Loans," about the growing problem of student loan debt, and also about tips on how loans can be better managed.

Divorce/Communication – 04/10/16 – IT – Interview with Chana Levitan, Marriage Counselor and Author, about how couples can better manage different personality traits, and about the need for better communication.

Economy/Seniors – 05/01/16 – IT – Interview with Phil DeMuth, Author of “The Overtaxed Investor”, about tax-saving strategies for personal investors, and also about new consumer protection laws.

Health/Food Safety – 05/01/16 - IT – Interview with Ellen Moyer, Environmental Researcher, about efforts to get GMO food labeling, and about food safety.

Big Government/Mental Health – 05/01/16 – IT – Interview with Angelo McClain, Chief Executive Officer of Nat. Assn. of Social Workers, about the work of the over 600,000 social workers in the country, and about some the challenges they face.

Terrorism/Economy – 05/29/16 – IT – Interview with Eric Markowitz, Senior Reporter for International Business Times, about the growing problem of cyber attacks that could eventually include the United States, and about the effects of these attacks on the economy.

Education/Debt – 05/29/16 – IT – Interview with Steven Roberts, College Funding Expert, with some tips on how people can save money on college funding, and about reducing college debt.

Health/Women – 05/29/16 – IT – Interview with Sherry Torkos, Holistic Pharmacist, about the growing problem of summer bacteria, and about natural remedies to fix the problem.

Government Debt/Economy – 06/05/16 – IT – Interview with Lowell Ponte, Financial Researcher and Author, about the growing economic challenges in Puerto Rico, and about the effects on American taxpayers.

Peer Pressure/Communication – 06/05/16 – IT – Interview with Rich Wessenberg, Societal Trends Author, about why positive role models are

important to society, and about the need for better communication and positive peer pressure.
