4<sup>th</sup> QUARTER - 2020

Listed below are some of the significant issues responded to by Radio Station KVNN-AM, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period October 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020. The listing is by no means exhaustive or all-inclusive. These issues were in part ascertained through discussions with service-providers and general interaction of station staff with the community, and staff knowledge of the community and area occurrences. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any particular priority.

The following issues were principal topics or themes within the station's weekly public affairs program, "Issues Today" (IT), which is broadcast on Sunday Mornings at 7:00am. Each program has a normal running time (or length) in the range of 29 to 30 minutes. Each program is usually in two or three parts, each dealing with separate topics and issues.

Seniors/Health - 10/04/20 - IT - Interview with Ben Kehl, Vice President of United Healthcare Medicare and Retirement, about Medicare options for those who are eligible, and about the differences in plans.

Unemployment/Coronavirus - 10/04/20 - IT - Interview with Jill Gonzalez, Analyst with Wallethub, about the results of research into which states are lowering unemployment rates the fastest, and about lingering effects of Coronavirus.

Veterans/Disabled Rights - 10/04/20 - IT - Interview with Al Kovach, Former Navy SEAL and Past President of Paralyzed Veterans of America, about difficulties some vets have in voting, and about a website with voting options for vets.

Consumerism/Communication - 10/11/20 - IT - Interview with Cousin Brucie Morrow, Legendary DJ, about the state of the radio business, and about his move to New York Station WABC from Sirius XM.

Coronavirus/Health - 10/11/20 - IT - Interview with Julie Swann, Professor at North Carolina State University, about herd immunity as it relates to the Coronavirus, and about getting America back to good health.

Health/Communication - 10/11/20 - IT - Interview with Kia Malone, Lifestyle Expert and Health Advocate, about pain management, and about some new treatments that include heat and cold remedies.

Seniors/Health - 10/25/20 - IT - Interview with Dr. Jonathan Graff-Radford, Viral Neurologist at Mayo Clinic, about research and treatments for Alzheimer's disease, and about a new book from the Mayo Clinic for patients and caregivers.

Environment/Coronavirus - 11/01/20 - IT - Interview with David Ribeiro, Member of American Council for Energy Efficient Economy, with a report on American cities who have adopted environmental policies, and about possible effects of Covid on future efforts.
