## Section I. Issues

The stations has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter.

- **A.** Idaho State Veteran's Issues (Aired on July 1). What is the state of Veteran's Administration in the Gem State? We explore opportunities for new and older veterans in Idaho.

- A. **Idaho State Veteran's Issues.** Journalist and bestselling author, Dennis Mansfield looks at the state of care for veterans in Idaho and across the country. State of Idaho Issues. Mr. Mansfield attended West Point and has personally counseled veterans and their families on job training and mental health issues. He shares with us the challenges of those returning home to the civilian world.
- B. Economic Trade in Idaho and America. Former White House Advisor to the Vice President, Steve Yates, reports on Idaho's overtures into international trade. Recently Idaho has engaged in several international trade missions to China, Taiwan, and other countries in Asia. Mr. Yates shares how those countries view business and trade in comparison to America. He covers how many new jobs these trade missions could bring to Idaho. History of Idaho and Legal Issues. Former Lieutenant Governor and Idaho State Attorney

- C. Washington DC Update Washington DC Lobbyist Phil Hardy joins us from Washington to review the first half of the year in politics. He reports on how different the relationship is between Congress and the Trump Administration when compared to the Obama Administration. Mr. Hardy believes that Congress will work harder to top the practice of passing continuing resolutions to fund the country.
- D. Idaho Alternative Medicine Verses Traditional Medical Care. Health Activist, Bob Neugenbaurer, details the growth in both traditional and nontraditional medicine in Idaho. Several new hospitals and the state's first medical school have opened recently. In additional the popularity of self-healing and faith healing have grabbed headlines. Mr. Neugenbaurer previews a new documentary on faith healing in Idaho that will be shown on A&E.
- E. **Idaho Economic Growth / Retirement Plans.** Financial Analyst Dave Petso reviews the current state of growth in our national financial markets. He goes behind the headlines of the president's trade deals and how they've fueled the stock market. Mr. Petso says that more people will be able to retire comfortably thanks to the market growth.
- F. How to find a job in the nation's fastest growing state. John Tamny, best-selling author and editor of Real Clear Markets shares his secrets on finding a career instead of a job. He goes over the employment verses unemployment numbers in the Western States and reveals what industries in those states are actively seeking workers. The growing construction and tech industry in Idaho were discussed in detail.
- G. Idaho General Election Preview Veteran Idaho Political Researcher Steve Ackerman looks at the aftermath of Idaho's Primary Election. Mr. Ackerman previews the two upcoming ballot initiatives, Medicaid Expansion and the return of Horse Racing Machines. He explains how these two issues could help Idaho Democratic Gubernatorial Candidate Paulette Jordan. If elected she would be the state's first female and the nation's first Native American Governor. Congressional and state seats races were previewed.
- H. **Spirit of Boise Balloon Classic Preview.** Veteran Balloon Pilot and Ambassador Scott Spencer shares the economic impact of the Treasure Valley's signature event. The 'Balloon Classic attracts visitors from across the state, country, and world. This event is free and open to the public.
- I. The State of Politics in America. A panel of Idaho political experts led by Congressman Raul Labrador discuss the lack of civility in American Politics. He previews the upcoming battle over the Supreme Court Justice Brett Kavanaugh. The congressman, an attorney, discusses how someone becomes a Supreme Court Justice.

- J. Idaho Gun Rights. Gregg Pruett, chairman of the Idaho Second Amendment Alliance, previews the upcoming battle for expanded gun rights in the Gem State. Thanks to his work, Idaho Residents do not need a permit to conceal carry their handguns in public. Mr. Pruett believes the state should have a stronger 'stand your ground law' and a stronger 'castle doctrine.'
- K. **Idaho Health Concerns**. Dr. Rosie Main reviews the pros and cons of the battle over Medicaid Expansion in Idaho. Both sides have spent a considerable amount of money publicizing this issue. Dr. Main breakdown the cost to the state budget for additional medical coverage for those folks who are currently not covered by the state of Idaho.
- L. Job Training for Idaho Veterans. Combat veteran and successful entrepreneur, Isaac Beldon discusses the advantages of hiring veterans to help Idaho Businesses. He promotes his free veteran job fair and let's everyone know of a several web sites that highlight the commitment, teamwork, and skills of Idaho Veterans.
- M. Gem State Business Growth. Idaho is the country's fastest growing state. With growth, comes a demand for skilled workers, who relocate with their families. Ron Price, business owner, and Stacy Ennis, publisher, discuss the innovative ways Idaho Businesses are attracting workers to the Gem State. The additional demands and expansion of the state's infrastructure, jobs, roads, schools, etc., is covered during the program.
- **N. Free Health Clinic.** Dr. Michael Karlfeldt reveals how he and several area doctors are joining forces to provide a free weekend health clinic. Dr. Karlfeldt lists the number of health issues that can be prevented if they are diagnosed early. He notes that Idaho is one of the 'healthiest' states in the union, but more can be done if folks get themselves checked out.
