

Text of Post-Filing Announcement for WKXD-FM

On July 27, 2012, WKXD-FM was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until August 1, 2020.

Our license will expire on August 1, 2020. We have filed an application for renewal with the FCC.
