2	Internship Program (Summer 2019)	During this reporting period, our SEU hosted ten (10) student interns from: Abilene Christian University (1), Dallas Baptist University (1), Santa Clara University (1), Tarrant County College District (1), Texas Tech University (2), University of Arkansas (1), University of North Texas (3). These interns assisted the Programming Department and “shadowed” Department Managers to learn about the operations and responsibilities of the department. 4	Management-level training regarding methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and prevention of discrimination and harassment	During the month of April 2019, this SEU participated in harassment prevention training. All SEU employees were required to complete a course prepared by ThinkHR entitled, “Workplace Harassment Prevention,” designed to address sexual harassment with a focus on the forms of harassment prohibited by federal law. The course presented best practices for updating policies and procedures, reporting incidents, and following up on complaints. The course for managers was more extensive than the course for staff members. In order to obtain a certificate of participation, employees were required to take a quiz following their completion of the tutorial.
