You can develop hearing loss before you even notice the problem. Once it happens, you can't reverse it and treatment becomes the best option. Importantly, in many cases, noise-induced hearing loss can be prevented.

Illinois is one of nine states that accounts for 51% of where Americans aged 65 or older reside. 2.1 million persons aged 65 or older live in Illinois, according to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

About 48 million adults experience some degree of hearing loss. Researchers say half of people between 12-35 are at risk of hearing loss due in part to exposure to loud sounds, including music pumped through personal audio devices. Hearing loss is already a problem among older people, with the condition now experienced by one-third of Americans between 64 and 75.

Consistent exposure to loud sounds, and exposure to a single loud sound, can contribute to hearing loss, which if left untreated may increase the risk of health conditions such as dementia. Joining us is Monica Murray, a doctor of audiology with UnitedHealthcare and a nationally recognized hearing health expert. She is here today to talk about hearing loss and ways we can protect our hearing, especially by trying to prevent noise-induced hearing loss.
