Falcon Broadcasting, Inc., licensee of KQMO, Shell Knob, Missouri (Facility ID No. 84490), submits this letter responding to your letter dated February 6, 2020. KQMO shares employees with Falcon Broadcasting's other station, KSWM, Aurora, Missouri (Facility ID No. 167) and two other stations licensed to Eagle Broadcasting, Inc.<sup>1</sup> Falcon Broadcasting, therefore, treats employees at each of these stations as a Station Employment Unit ("SEU").


As of the date of the Commission's letter, the SEU that includes KQMO had three (3) full-time employees, not including the owners of Falcon Broadcasting and Eagle Broadcasting. The SEU employees the following full-time employees: Sports/Ag Director – 37½-40 Hours/Week, Inside Sales/Traffic – 32 Hours/Week, and Announcer/News – 25-30 Hours/Week.

There are no pending or resolved complaints involving KQMO or any other station in the SEU, and there are no time brokerage agreements for KQMO or any other station in the SEU.

In accordance with Section 73.3527(e) of the Commission's rules, a copy of the EEO audit letter and this response will be placed in KQMO's Online Public Inspection File.
