On 4/9/2015 there were 7 tornadoes in North-Central Illinois. WTVO broke in with special weather reports as the severe storm warnings were issued. WTVO began continuous coverage at 6:21 pm when the first tornado warning was issued. Tornado strengths ranged from EF 0-EF4. The second tornado at 6:39, an EF 4 damaged the entire town of Fairdale and caused significant damage to Rochelle. The remaining tornadoes and severe thunderstorms caused damage and flash flooding throughout the Stateline area. WTVO remained live on the air until 8:38 pm-after the last weather warning expired. Expanded weather segments aired later in the 10:00 newscast. Live reports from Fairdale and Rochelle aired the following Morning at both 5:00 am & 6:00 am and again at 5:00 pm, 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm the next day.

WTVO provided significant coverage of Rockford's Airfest 2015. Airfest is the largest event in the region. This year a record setting 140,000 people attended. WTVO aired live newscasts number of news stories prior to the event to highlight the many attractions of Airfest as well as the boost it provides to the local economy.

Improving education in Rockford is critical. Although unemployment is a significant problem in the Stateline area, many of the jobs cannot be filled due to an undereducated population. “Bergstrom Stateline Quiz Bowl” is a station produced program. 2 regional high school scholastic teams are competed for \$40,000 in scholarship awards to Northern Illinois University. The program launched on Jan. 17, 2015 and aired weekly on WTVO at 6:30 pm on Saturdays and on WTVO-DT2 at 8:30 am on Sundays. The 90 minute championship finale aired live on WTVO from 6:30-8:00 pm on 5/29/2015. “Bergstrom Stateline Quiz Bowl” is part of a station wide initiative for Excellence in Education. Next season the program is expanding to 32 schools will return to the line-up in October 2015.

On 4/16/2015, WTVO partnered with the Red Cross and held a telethon from 5:00-am-7:00 pm to benefit the victims of the recent storms and tornado. Live cut-ins from the phone banks aired during the newscasts and throughout the day and \$121,000 was raised.

WTVO produced and aired live coverage of Rockford Rescue Mission’s An Evening for Hope telethon on 4/21/15 from 7:00-9:00 PM. The Rockford Rescue Mission is Rockford’s largest homeless shelter. It receives no Federal funding or United Way dollars. Over \$128,000 was raised on the telethon.
