## PLANTING SEEDS OF HOPE

BIG SPRING - West Texas Centers - the Local Mental Health Authority based in Big Spring - is hosting a Mental Health Awareness Event "Planting Seeds of Hope" to encourage gardening as a healthy coping mechanism to manage stress.

"Being outdoors, creating a working space that produces a tangible, useful outcome has proven to be an effective method of assisting with mental wellness," West Texas Centers CEO Shelley Smith said.

West Texas Centers is charged with providing Mental Health assistance in its 15 Mental Health clinics in their 23-county service area.

West Texas Centers Mental Health experts will provide education on Mental Health Awareness on May 9, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the West Texas Centers Harris Building, 3205 US Hwy 87.

"This event is to promote mental health awareness, recognize gardening as a healthy coping strategy, share hope and encouragement with those who fight the battle or have a loved one who battles mental illness," Smith said.

We are thankful for the Howard County Master Gardeners and local gardening experts from Johansen Landscape & Nursery. The Howard County Master Gardeners will be on hand to assist attendees in designing and planning a flower bed around the West Texas Centers Harris Building. Upon completion of the planting, each attendee will be presented with his or her own plant they may take home.

"We strongly believe that gardening and being outdoors is a strong outlet for people who need to cope with the stressors in their lives," Smith said. "We also believe the people who help with the planting will see how the plants will continue to thrive throughout the growing season and receive a great deal of joy from that."

"Plants have many similarities to people. If you don't care for them properly - watering, fertilizing, suitable planting areas, in full sun or shade, etc., they won't thrive or grow to their potential. We like to show our clients examples in which they can apply to their lives."
