There follows a listing of some of the most significant issues responded to by station WEDG-FM, Buffalo, New York, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period January 1, 2019 through March 31, 2019. The listing is by no means exhaustive. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority. The issues were covered on WEDG-FM's public affairs program on the dates indicated. The program is 30 minutes long and begins at 8:00 AM on Sundays.

ISSUE: United Way Service 1, United Way Service 2

DATE: January 6, 2019

DURATION: 28:00 (2 14-minute segments)

DESCRIPTION:

Discussed an overview of the Service Collaborative of WNY and introduction to United Way families news Ambassador.

ISSUE: The NACC – Niagara Arts & Cultural Center

DATE: January 13, 2019

DESCRIPTION:

The NACC is the largest multi-arts center in upstate New York. The NACC is home to more than 75 artists and arts groups. The NACC used the old High School in Niagara Falls and saved it from demolition and offer space to rent out to show exhibits and to take classes. The classes offered include painting, theater, music/voice, dance, martial arts, wood craft, computers and more. The NACC is open to the community at little to no cost.

Discussed the programs the pride center of WNY offers. One of the programs is the Care Givers program for dementia or Alzheimer's patients. They also offer a coffee get together for Seniors, free yoga and happy hours. The Happy Hours are a networking evening with businesses. It takes place at different bars that are big enough for the community to come together. They offer health care for the LGBTQ community, including AIDS screenings. They also handout free condoms. They are very involved with the community. They are always looking for volunteers and especially with their pride parade in June. That is their biggest event.
