GORDON - MAY 12, 2021

When couples experience the profound sense of pain and loss from a miscarriage, well-intentioned family members and friends can say hurtful things. But Dr. Walt and Barb Larimore, along with Russ and June Gordon, who have suffered a total of six miscarriages between them, urge those who wish to console others to simply say, "I am so sorry! God cares. And I love you." They share with host Dr. James Dobson that couples should name the lost baby, figuratively bury their

child, and allow themselves time to heal.

HOST: DR. TIM CLINTON - GUEST: CLAIRE CULWELL - MAY 25, 2021

When Claire Culwell turned 21, she desired to meet her birth mother who had placed her up for adoption. Nothing could have prepared her for what she discovered. Her birth mother, Tonya, was only 13 at the time of her pregnancy, and Tonya's mother had insisted that she get an abortion. However, the abortionist was unaware that Tonya was pregnant with twins, so only one of the children was aborted. Claire was the twin who survived! She shares her emotional story in her new book, *Survivor: An Abortion Survivor's Surprising Story of Choosing Forgiveness and Finding Redemption*.

HOST: DR. TIM CLINTON - GUEST: CLAIRE CULWELL - MAY 26, 2021

In Part 2 of "The Miracle of An Abortion Survivor," author Claire Culwell continues her inspirational account of miraculously surviving an abortion when her birth mother was only 13 years old. Claire forgave her birth mother, who came to faith in Christ. Years later, when Claire found herself pregnant out of wedlock, she again experienced the life-changing forgiveness of God. Inspired by her new-found friendship with Abby Johnson of the movie "Unplanned," Claire has become a powerful champion for life.

HOST: DR. TIM CLINTON - GUEST: LILA ROSE - JUNE 08, 2021

Dehumanization of a category of people always precedes injustice and violence, whether it was slaves in 19th century America, Jews during World War II, or preborn babies in the womb today. Lila Rose, author of *Fighting for Life: Becoming a Force for Change in a Wounded World*, calls on Christians to take a stand for the RE-humanization of these precious souls that God has created in His own image. Abortion sells the lie that the child in the womb is less than human, despite the biological evidence to the contrary.

FOCUS ON THE FAMILY

April 13: Fighting for Joy as a Special Needs Parent - He thought his faith was strong. But when his son was diagnosed with autism, Jason Hague began to question everything he knew about God. Jason shares what it's like to live with a constantly unanswered prayer - and unpacks the joys and challenges of parenting his distinctly unique child.

April 28: Finding God's Beauty in Alzheimer's and Dementia - Sarah was shocked when her fiercely independent mother was diagnosed with early onset Alzheimer's. Sarah Smith shares how she found God's goodness and learned sacrificial love as she cared for her mom.

FAMILY TALK

HOST: DR. JAMES DOBSON - GUEST: JOHN SMITHBAKER - APRIL 08, 2021

When John Smithbaker was born, his father had already abandoned the family and, tragically, had wanted John to be aborted. That "father wound" caused John to seek his self-worth in athletics and other ultimately empty pursuits. It's an all-too-common story. But Smithbaker's organization, "Fathers in the Field," is helping by finding Christian men to connect with and mentor fatherless boys.

HOST: DR. JAMES DOBSON - GUEST: JOHN SMITHBAKER - APRIL 09, 2021

For young children, love is spelled "T-I-M-E," so without a father in the home it can be traumatic. John Smithbaker, founder of "Fathers in the Field," experienced the forgiveness of Christ at the age of 40, and was empowered to forgive his earthly father for abandoning him as a child. His Christ-centered mentoring ministry urges the Church to play a role much like the Good Samaritan—instead of walking by fatherless boys left on the "cultural roadside," to find willing Christian men to invest time in their lives.

HOST: DR. TIM CLINTON - GUESTS: MARK AND JENNY SHAFFER, DR. JERRY KARTZINEL -

APRIL 19, 2021

Mark and Jenny were concerned when their first-born child wouldn't make eye contact, walked on his tiptoes, and didn't talk. At the age of three, he was diagnosed with autism, which sent Mark into a deep depression. He wondered if his son would ever graduate from high school or drive a car. In addition, having an autistic child became incredibly isolating as friends found their child's behavior disruptive. But, ultimately, the entire family found hope and strength to move forward.

HOST: DR. TIM CLINTON - GUESTS: MARK AND JENNY SHAFFER, DR. JERRY KARTZINEL -

APRIL 20, 2021

When pediatrician Dr. Jerry Kartzinel puts autistic children on a dairy and gluten-free diet, 75% of them respond dramatically—like a fog has lifted! He analogizes that these kids are like computers with a malfunctioning hard drive. Only after the "hard drive" has been repaired can "software" like speech and other therapies that are introduced show dramatic results.

HOST: DR. TIM CLINTON - GUEST: DR. MATTHEW STANFORD - MAY 10, 2021

Psalm 139:23 says, "Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts and lead me in the way everlasting." Dr. Matthew Stanford, author of *Grace for the Children*, explains, "God not only knows children's thoughts, but also their hearts. While He celebrates children's joys, He also feels their pain and frustration." Whether your child is struggling with autism, depression, or Attention Deficit Disorder, Dr. Stanford wants you to know that there is no shame in getting professional help.

HOST: DR. TIM CLINTON - GUEST: DR. JOHN TRENT AND DR. DEWEY WILSON - MAY 21, 2021

While it's easy to understand what it means to be mentally intelligent, what does it take to be relationally intelligent? God wants us to thrive in our relationships. But sadly, because of sin, otherwise healthy relationships have become distorted between God and man, parent and child, and within peer groups. Guests John Trent and Dewey Wilson, co-authors of *The Relationally Intelligent Child*, sit down with Dr. Tim Clinton to explain how parents can pass on relational behaviors to their children. They encourage imparting crucial skills such as fearless exploration, unwavering resilience, and wise decision-making.

HOST: DR. JAMES DOBSON - GUEST: ROB AND DIANNE PARSONS - JUNE 04, 2021

Mothers continue to be under-appreciated and undervalued in our culture. But when her husband is guilty of this himself, his wife can feel even more neglected, and this will often lead to depression. Rob and Dianne Parsons, co-authors of *The 60 Minute Mother*, underscore the importance of mothers being vulnerable with one another and admitting that their family lives aren't perfect. This is when stressed-out moms can best discover the grace and guidance of God and only then do they find the appreciation they deserve in life's simple moments.

HOST: DR. JAMES DOBSON - GUEST: SARAH PARSHALL PERRY - JUNE 09, 2021

After establishing a successful career as an attorney, Sarah Parshall Perry and her husband had three children, two of whom are on the autism spectrum. Called by God to stay at home to raise her children, Sarah wondered whether simply ensuring that her kids were fed and dressed was all she could do. So, sporting the proverbial messy ponytail and dirty yoga pants, she authored *Mommy Needs a Raise (Because Quitting Is Not an Option)*, in which she encourages Christian moms to seek God and embrace humility and forgiveness.

Heidi St. John offers encouragement to moms, especially if you feel afraid, overwhelmed, and discouraged by everyday tasks. June 15: Loving Your Spouse Through the Seasons of Marriage – I - When you and your spouse fall in love, it's like springtime! You'll hear how every marriage will experience different “seasons” — spring, summer, fall and winter. Are you

June 16: Loving Your Spouse Through the Seasons of Marriage – II - Every marriage has seasons — spring, summer, fall and winter. But how do you navigate chilly and bitter times with your spouse? We'll examine how “fall and winter seasons” of a marriage can lead to new growth and another spring!
