Issue: **Duration**:

27 min 49 sec

Description: Averaging less than 10 inches of rainfall per year, the San Joaquin Valley is dependent on reservoirs to hold water from other places in order to satisfy both residential and agricultural needs. The San Luis Reservoir in the Pacheco State Park receives water from Lake Shasta and Lake Oroville in Northern California. When full it can hold 2,038,000 acre feet (an acre foot is approximately 326,000 gallons) of water. At the time the program was made the reservoir was at 47% capacity. The reservoir is the main source of irrigation water for the west side of the San Joaquin Valley. The lakes are very popular with fisherman and boaters, although care must be taken due to the very strong winds which can occur in the area. A visitor center at the Romero Overlook provides full information on the reservoirs and water projects through audio-visual and printed materials.
