This week, Quinnipiac University released a survey on the US President's handling of the economy. 55% of those polled disapprove of how President Biden is running the economic reins of the country and only 39% approve of it. Examples: In April of last year a gallon of gasoline, the average price of the country plummeted to a dollar with 77 cents, this week the average price reached three dollars and 28 cents and in states like California to four dollars and forty-four cents . As we have reported, the 2020 census counted 62 million Latinos who did respond to the census last year. And of course we know that there are more of us, but what is impressive is what we generate economically. The organization "Latino donor collaborative" reported that the total economic production of Latinos living in this country would be the equivalent of the gross domestic product of \$ 2.7 billion. We are talking about the fact that only Latinos produce more than the gross domestic product of complete countries like Italy, Brazil or Canada. And

if we talk about Mexicans, the level of remittances is after India and China the third in the world with listen well 43 billion dollars annually. This week we spoke with the ambassador of Mexico in United States Esteban Moctezuma Barragán on bilateral issues, the impact of the pandemic and the need for reciprocity between both countries in areas of organized crime, arms and drug trafficking.

someone known to the victim. Most of the killings were with firearms, according to a report by the Policy Center for Violence. According to the report, the highest rate of femicides in a year was recorded in Alaska, followed by New Mexico, Nevada, New Hampshire and Louisiana. Most of the murdered women were primarily white, African-American as well as Latina among others. However, there are some women who prefer not to become a statistician and take matters into their own hands. In the past year alone, more women than men bought firearms. Alex Zapata from Las Vegas, Nevada told us more on the subject.

This week the Johns Hopkins University reported that the United States accumulates more deaths from covid-19 this year than in all of 2020! Just last week, the 700,000 deaths associated with covid-19 had been exceeded, making it the country most affected in the world by the pandemic. In the last 28 days, 53 thousand Americans have died and the state with the most deaths is California. Texas is second in the nation. The only defense remains the vaccines available literally around the corner, but tens of thousands say no to the drug. This plan, according to a study by the Center for American Progress, would benefit 7.1 million undocumented immigrants.
