## Community Issues list

### **1. Education**

Equal access to adequate health insurance. Using local hospital emergency rooms as a doctor’s office. Expressed need for a national health care system. The growing obesity epidemic. Patients should pay for their healthcare.

### **4. Economy and Employment**

Rising cost of energy prices. Large loss of jobs throughout the listening area. Negative local impact of job outsourcing and automation. Unemployment throughout the country. Need higher paying jobs.

## **5. Environment**

Run down houses in local neighborhoods and the money that the city spends to keep them from becoming hazards. Praise and complaints regarding the upkeep and maintenance of local roads. Complaints against animal shelters. Problems caused by business and residential neighborhoods being vacated and allowed to deteriorate. Cost of sewer services too high. More money for Public Parks.

## **6. Substance Abuse**

Drunk driving and the risk it pits the members of the community in. Parents sending wrong message to kids when they drive after drinking. Tobacco addiction.
