Community Issues list

1. Education

Rising cost of energy prices. Large loss of jobs throughout the listening area. Negative local impact of job outsourcing and automation. Unemployment throughout the country. Need higher paying jobs.

5. Environment

Run down houses in local neighborhoods and the money that the city spends to keep them from becoming hazards. Praise and complaints regarding the upkeep and maintenance of local roads. Complaints against animal shelters. Problems caused by business and residential neighborhoods being vacated and allowed to deteriorate. Cost of sewer services too high. More money for Public Parks.

6. Substance Abuse

Drunk driving and the risk it pits the members of the community in. Parents sending wrong message to kids when they drive after drinking. Tobacco addiction. Need for advertising and intervention programs in the community to help lower teen drinking and drug abuse. Need solutions to drug use. People on public assistance should be drug tested.

7. Crime

General feeling that no one is interested in lowering the crime rate. Discipline problems in the schools. Families that are the victims of burglary and home invasions. Need for mentoring programs for at-risk youth. Voluntary gun turn in program. Minor street crimes. Crime rate in Akron.

8. Roads/Driving

Roads are in disrepair and city should pay for automobile damage. Drivers should not be allowed to drive using cell phones in the winter. Too many drivers speeding in areas where children are playing.
