Issues

The station has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter aired at 7:30am, 8:00am & 8:30am in 3 minute news features called Q-Newstrends:

- 1.) **Public Safety:** Issues relating to the public safety and welfare of local listeners in Central Massachusetts.
- 2.) **Health:** Issues relating to issues that pose a health risk in the local community, epidemics, public safety notices that relate to above issues.
- 3.) **Government/Financial:** Issues relating to local & state budgetary issues and how it relates to the local taxpayer in our community.
- 4.) **Extreme Weather:** Issues relating to extreme weather conditions, school closings, cancellations, weather watches & warnings & state issued protocols.
- 5.) **Drug Epidemic:** The ongoing issue of drug abuse, epidemic and opioid addiction in our community and solutions being offered.
- 6.) **Transportation:** Issues relating to public transportation not limited to WRTA, Mass Transit, road construction or traffic impacts on major highways.
- 7.) **Housing & Homelessness:** Issues relating to the advancement of helping those seeking shelter, housing assistance in the local community.
- 8.) **Education:** Issues relating to education, local schools, budgets and welfare of students on the public & private level.
