SECTION A: NEWSCAST OVERVIEW AND QUARTERLY ISSUES ADDRESSED

WRBN Radio produces daily newscasts that air on a regularly scheduled basis. A one-minute news tease is aired at the bottom of the hour Monday through Friday between 6:00am and 9:00am. On WRBN, just after ABC news at the top of the hour between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00am Monday through Friday, WRBN airs a 3-minute live newscast. A two-minute recorded newscast airs at 12:00pm and at 4:00pm, 5:00pm, and 6:00pm Monday through Friday on WRBN. These are two-minutes in length. WRBN reports local and area news events and issues on an ongoing basis.

News Treatments: The nominal length of each of our lead or feature news stories described below is between 30-seconds and one minute. One to two versions of each story aired multiple times during a 12-hour news cycle and are posted online.

Some of the issues covered in these newscasts and programs during the **first** quarter are as follows. Dates indicate local news treatment unless otherwise noted.

1- ELECTIONS

News Treatments: May, July

We routinely give updates regarding election dates and turnouts prior to and during early elections and on election day. We also report on all public forums the candidates are involved in, and Meetings of the Local Elections Board. The May Primary took place during this period. One race, the Distrct 8 state house, resulted in a runoff. That election will take place in July.

<u>2-</u> PUBLIC COMMENT CONTROVERSY

News Treatments:June

A handful of residents have complained of the issues concerning the way that public comment is administered during the Rabun County Commission meetings every month. I asked other news directors about how their respective county commission's handle public comment, and provided the results during a newscast. +

<u>3-COUNCIL/COMMISSIONER MEETINGS</u>

News Treatments: May, June, July

The radio station covers almost every local government function, which at times are not always attended in great numbers. The station provides a service by informing the public of what happens in their local government.

4- RABUN COUNTY WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITY

The Water and Sewer Authority announced during this period their intentions to sue the city of Clayton over service delivery area. Updates are provided in newscasts when made available.
