SHERMAN HILLS SHOOTING - 28 year old Diondre Bess who was wanted in the shooting at the Sherman Hills Apartment complex in Wilkes-Barre was taken into custody by U.S. Marshals Service Fugitive Task Force. The incident occurred on March 23rd of this year. He was charged with attempted homicide, illegal possession of a firearm and related counts.

WILKES-BARRE FATAL SHOOTING -37 year old Jose Rodriguez, the victim of a fatal shooting was identified and police released the description of the two people believed to have been the suspects. The public was notified that it was an isolated incident.

WALMART SHOOTING – Scott Sargent from Shenandoah allegedly opened fire at the Wal-Mart in Wilkes-Barre Township. He pulled out an semi-automatic rifle and started firing. He also began firing at police when they arrived on scene. Sargent was shot by police, and was treated at a local trauma center. He was charged with the crime. There were no other injuries reported. The trail is still pending in court.

ARMED HOLD-UP IN WEST HAZLETON – A 22 year old West Hazleton man was arrested following an armed robbery at the local Pantry Quick in the borough. He allegedly walked in after 10:30PM earlier that week and pulled a knife on the clerk and demanded money. He was charged with two counts of robbery and a list of lesser charges. Police also state that he was a suspect in two other robberies that were still under investigation.

Listeria is a common organism found in nature and consumption of food contaminated with listeria can cause high fever, severe headaches, neck stiffness and nausea.
