## 2nd Quarter 2013 Community Issues Report Summary

WYLN'S LATE EDITION: This is an hour-long news magazine with features news stories of local, regional and statewide issues, regularly featuring comments from local officials with roles in those stories and their effects. It also features two long-form interview segments, during which elected and appointed officials are interviewed concerning issues of local and regional importance. It also features local and national sports stories and a regional weather reports. It is produced live and runs Monday through Friday between 10 PM and 11 PM. It is rebroadcast the following morning at 8 AM. (Video copies of this program are available upon request or may be viewed at WYLN's studios and offices during normal business hours. Scripts of the headlines run each day may be viewed at WYLN's studios and offices during normal business hours.

**TOPIC A LIVE AT 5:** This is a live, daily discussion program about events and issues of local, regional and statewide importance. It also features several weather segments which give detailed forecasts and information for each different segment of our coverage area. It features a look at each day's news headlines and three extended segments of discussion of issues of importance locally, regionally and statewide. It airs Monday through Friday at 5 PM and is rebroadcast nightly at 7 PM. This program is a continuation of two earlier programs, **Topic A** and **35 Weather**. Those two programs had the same goals as the current show, but were done in separate half-hour programs. They began in 2010. They were combined into one program in the second quarter of 2011.

**LIVE LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL:** Taped 4 games of the Valley West Little League and broadcast them at least once just days after the game.

**STORM POLICITICS – POLICITICAL TALK:** Each week host Tiffany Cloud discusses issues and concerns of a political nature. (video copies of shows available at WYLN in Hazleton)

**WOMAN TODAY:** A show for women, hosted by Liz Tolan, covering topics on dating, makeovers, home decorating, women in business, etc.

**HELPING HANDS TELETHON:** Produced live in April from the Laurel Mall in Hazle Township. WYLN produces and carries a telethon annually for the Helping Hands Society Telethon and is broadcast from 11 a.m. – Midnight. Helping Hands is a local charity that raises money to help infants, toddlers and children with learning disabilities at the Helping Hands Society in Hazleton.

**LOCAL ELECTION RETURNS:** Taking place in May, WYLN had Live election coverage of races around the viewing area.

**OFF THE BEATEN PATH:** A locally produced program that features three separate segments highlighting the fun and interesting people and places in Pennsylvania. Hosts include, Jeff Bonomo, Ken Cara, Chris Fulmer.

**WELLNESS THRU PHYSICAL THERAPY:** Hosted by Liz Tolan, the show features a local Physical Therapist discussing issues that can be treated through physical therapy.

**LEGALLY SPEAKING:** Hosted by Liz Tolan, it is a show that features a local Attorney from the Hazleton Area, discussing legal matters.

**JENTASTIC SWEETS:** Hosted by Chef Jen Yamola who gives viewers a first hand lessons on baking sweet treats.

**THE CHEF LOU SHOW:** Hosted by Chef Lou, he gives viewers a first hand lesson at making dinner style food with an Italian flare.

**HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION:** Live coverage of Hazleton Area High School Graduation in May. Supply video support for graduation ceremony, and DVD copy of graduation is provided.

**WEATHERLY HILLCLIMB SHOW:** Program featuring a background on the race which has been held for years in the borough of Weatherly. It includes a number of segments on cars, drivers, and other community aspects.

**WEATHERLY HILLCLIMB:** A live two-day broadcast, where drivers race their vehicles up a steep hill competing for the best time in the borough of Weatherly.

**WYOMING VALLEY RIVERFEST:** RiverFest is a two-day event held annually at the Riverfront Common in the city of Wilkes-Barre, celebrating the Susquehanna River. WYLN does a live broadcast both days from the event, talking to performers, environmentalists, and local officials.

Information on specific stories on newscasts are available Monday through Friday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. News Scripts are archived on paper back up. Copies of newscasts and locally produced shows are also available upon request. Beginning in July of 2008, copies of news scripts are kept in data base in EZ News and are available for review.
