## SUPPLEMENTAL RECRUITMENT INITIATIVES

The employment unit engaged in the following broad outreach initiatives in accordance with various elements of FCC Rule 73.2080(c)(2):

*Participation in at least four (4) job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions.*

The stations participated in the following job fairs during the reporting period: 1) Newmark Journalism School Virtual Career Fair (October, 2020); 2) Investigative Editor Virtual Career Fair (September, 2020); 3) Albertus Magnus Career and Internship Fair (March, 2020); 4) Veteran's Showcase Hiring Event (March, 2020); and 5) NABJ Regional Conference (January, 2020).

*Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.*

The stations have a robust internship program designed to train students and members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment. Six (6) students participated in internships in the marketing, social media, education, and radio talk shows areas. In addition, the stations were the recipient of grants from several individual funders, which funded four (4) internships in the newsroom focused in the areas of integrity in journalism.

*Listing of each upper-level category opening in a job bank or newsletter of media trade groups whose membership includes substantial participation of women and minorities.*

The stations routinely advertise job openings in several job banks, including *CT Hires* and the *Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB) Jobline*, and promotes recruiting opportunities through diverse journalism conferences for the recruitment of people of color. Such conferences include the National Association of Black Journalists (NABJ).

*Sponsored at least two (2) events in the community designed to inform and educate members of the public as to employment opportunities in broadcasting.*

The stations operate a State of Connecticut-accredited occupational school called the *Institute for Advanced Media (IAM)* which offers direct learning to help students expand their personal and professional skills. Courses offered are in the areas of television video production, editing, public speaking, and project management. Twenty-three (23) students were enrolled in the IAM during the reporting period.
