In a 1999 rulemaking proceeding, the FCC retained the requirement that stations must maintain a list of all program funders in their public inspection files for a period of two years from the airing date of the underwritten program. A simple list of funders by name is all that is required. (T) denotes a trade account and that services or products were provided by the underwriter rather than cash.
