WILD KRATTS - Animals can take you anywhere in science! Creature teachers Chris and Martin Kratt take kids and their families along on extraordinary animal-powered adventures in "Wild Kratts." The show transforms the Kratt Brothers, creators of the award-winning Kratts' Creatures and Emmy-winning Zoboomafoo, into animated versions of themselves, allowing the real-life zoologists to visit wild animals in their little-seen habitats and showcase key science concepts along the way. From elephants using physics to suck gallons of water with their trunks to a fleet of peregrine falcons that harness the force of gravity to speed through the air, each half-hour episode of "Wild Kratts" presents age-appropriate science inspired by the natural abilities of the animals that the Kratt brothers – and young viewers – meet.
