Pre-Filing Announcement

On March 29, 2007 WMEA-TV, WMEB-TV, WMED-TV, WMEM-TV, & WCBB-TV were granted licenses by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until April 1, 2015.

Our license will expire on April 1, 2015. We must file an application for renewal with the FCC by December 1, 2014. When filed, a copy of this application will be available for public inspection at www.fcc.gov. It contains information concerning this station's performance during the last eight years.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application and to whether this station has operated in the public interest should file comments and petitions with the FCC by March 1, 2015.
