Dear Mr. Stern:

Your letter of February 13, 2015 was referred to me. I am pleased to learn that you are planning a new system to serve the Raleigh – Durham area.

Since WUNC-TV is a qualifying noncommercial educational station, we can not make an election. WUNC-TV is entitled to carriage under the must carry provisions of Part 76 of the FCC rules. The retransmission consent and must carry decision that is defined by 76.64 only applies to commercial television stations. WUNC-TV formally requests carriage on Channel 4 or other negotiated channel under the current must carry rules.

UNC-TV is the PBS member statewide noncommercial educational television network operating in the state of North Carolina. WUNC-TV is one of 12 full power stations in that network. UNC-TV would like to offer any of our other digital services at no charge to your customers. These include UNC-EX, the Explorer channel; UNC-KD, the children's channel; and UNC-MX. All of these channels including UNC-TV in HD are carried by cable systems throughout North Carolina.

Since these services are duplicated on all 12 full power stations, if it is technically easier for you to use the signal of one of the other UNC-TV stations, please do so.
