Issues/Programs for the period of 2nd Quarter 2014

Issue: Mammoth Mountain Ski Area – Stories dealing with ski area development as the prime economic factor, ongoing operational issues, real estate development, area economics.

Issue: Law Enforcement – Stories dealing with criminal activities, natural and man-made disasters, court cases. Also, stories about specific crimes, arrestees, court proceedings and law enforcement activities as they relate to disaster planning and response.

Issue: Local political bodies activities – Stories dealing with Los Angeles Dept. of Water and Power issues, housing, air service, health news, meetings of locally elected officials and their discussions and votes on water issues, affordable housing, schools, the search for air service and other civic matters.

Issue: Government bureaucracy issues – National and local issues are covered in a regular news feature called the Bureaucrat Beat every Tuesday and Friday in radio news.

Above issues all covered in the daily radio news which airs 7A, 8A, noon and 5P Monday through Friday. Eastern Sierra News with Benett Kessler – approximately 20 minutes in length. The news reporting covers government body meetings, ranging from Mammoth Lakes and Bishop city and Inyo and Mono county supervisor's meetings to local hospitals and school boards. It also includes investigative reports and taped soundbites and interviews of officials and citizens on the issues.

During the news hours and at other times in the day, air stories of highway updates, weather bulletins, forest fire news.
