The message that warned of an imminent ballistic missile attack was sent out about 8:05 a.m. to all cell phones in Hawaii.
1	19	1'15"	Confirmed cases of mumps in outbreak top 800	As the mumps outbreak in Hawaii continues to rage on, the state is renewing its call for adults to get vaccinated.
