**Gospel Bill** – Sheriff Gospel Bill, his deputy Nicodemus, and other western characters make up the town of Dry Gulch. Children learn about the difference between good and evil in this light drama set in the Old West. Also, Nicodemus sings in music videos that teach on the subject covered in the story. Ages 6 – 12

**K.I.C.K.S. Club** - Ralph the puppet encourages children to share and study The Word of God. Ralph also lets the children know that, "You're a winner in Christ!"

**The Legend of Gaither's Pond** - The adventures of Big Bass and his "fish head friends" teach children how to make the right decisions in life. Singing, dancing, and Christian comedy make the program exciting and entertaining.

**God Rocks** - Chip, Gem, Splinter, and Carb tell bible stories and verses through music and skits in a live action/animation format.

**Dooley and Pals** - Dooley a space alien and his young earth friends share biblical concepts through songs and skits.

**Worship for Kids** - This program shows music videos of worship songs geared towards children. It also inter mixes its videos with visual story telling of Christian ethics.

**Ewe Know** – Each episode features the adventures of a flock of sheep under the wise care of the Great Shepherd. The sheep live on the 6 ½ acre Iowan Panhandle. A pack of inept wolves that are constantly in pursuit of a tasty meal try to trick the sheep into capture, but they usually end up much like the coyote we all know. Each episode is packed full of amusing songs, silly vignettes and wrapped in powerful life lessons.

**Dr. Wonders Workshop** – Each episode features uplifting and educational messages geared towards children. Everyone in the workshop is deaf, and every bit of the show is in sign language (with audio accompaniment).
