

**WRDC(TV) First Quarter 2019 Children's Television  
Programming Report Explanatory Document**

In the Children's Television Programming Report for First Quarter 2019, WRDC(TV) inadvertently omitted the description for one of the core programs the station planned to air in the following quarter (*Culture Click*). Because stations are no longer able to amend previously filed quarterly Children's Television Programming Reports, and consistent with the FCC's Form 303-S instructions, WRDC(TV) is providing information here that would have otherwise been provided in its First Quarter 2019 Children's Television Programming Report.

<b>Program Title</b>	Culture Click
<b>Describe the educational and informational objective of the program and how it meets the definition of Core Programming.</b>	This program explores connections in history which affect pop culture and our lives today. Using a unique flowchart style, the program draws surprising connections between such subjects such as what do Justin Bieber and Cleopatra have in common, or what connection did John Wilkes Booth have to Abraham Lincoln, or what do cavemen have to do with pancakes. Through these comparisons, the program introduces the viewer to American history, Greek mythology, and architecture, as well as fashion and pop culture, and inspires the viewer to learn more about the subjects. This program will air on the station's main digital stream.
