

**WRDC(TV) Second Quarter 2018 Children's Television
Programming Report Explanatory Document**

In the Children's Television Programming Report for Second Quarter 2018, WRDC(TV) inadvertently omitted the description for one of the core programs the station aired that quarter (*Rescue Me with Dr. Lisa*). Because stations are no longer able to amend previously filed quarterly Children's Television Programming Reports, and consistent with the FCC's Form 303-S instructions, WRDC(TV) is providing information here that would have otherwise been provided in its Second Quarter 2018 Children's Television Programming Report.

Program Title	Rescue Me with Dr. Lisa
Describe the educational and informational objective of the program and how it meets the definition of Core Programming.	This program is about a veterinarian's mission to match orphaned pets with new owners and new homes. Episode examples include finding a dog for a mother and her two young daughters; and, overcoming the challenge of finding a dog for a family who doesn't know what they want. Children will learn what it takes to be a responsible pet owner. This program aired on the station's main digital stream.
