DESCRIPTION: SHOTS FIRED (Crime)

YAKIMA POLICE ARE SEARCHING FOR TWO PEOPLE SUSPECTED OF SHOOTING A MAN SUNDAY NIGHT. POLICE SAY THE VICTIM WAS SHOT IN THE ANKLE NEAR THE 12-HUNDRED BLOCK OF EIGHTH AVENUE. HE TOLD POLICE HE WAS OUTSIDE ON HIS FRONT PORCH WHEN TWO MEN APPROACHED HIM AND STARTED SHOOTING. POLICE SAY THE MAN DIDN'T KNOW THE SUSPECTS OR WHY THEY WOULD HURT HIM. THE VICTIM DIDN'T HAVE A DESCRIPTION OF THE MEN OR THEIR CAR.

DESCRIPTION: EAST VALLEY LOCKDOWN

East Valley High School leaders are pressing charges against a student's family for trespassing, claiming they entered the school illegally Monday afternoon causing the school to go on lockdown. The principal of East Valley says a student's mother, along with two other family members, claimed her son had been jumped by another student. The principal says this was a false claim and that the family members refused to leave and became verbally aggressive. To ensure the safety of the student body school workers called 911 to have them removed. The school went on lockdown for about an hour.

They're going to lie about who they are what their intentions are but it's nothing but bad news so you need to sit down and have these conversations with your kid that there are predators out there" POLICE SAY AS A PARENT YOU SHOULD BE IN CONTROL, AND FRIEND OR FOLLOW YOUR OWN CHILD ON THE SOCIAL MEDIA SITES THEY'RE ON.

POLICE SAY A MAN AND A WOMAN WENT INTO THE STORE SATURDAY NIGHT AT 16TH AVENUE AND JEROME AVENUE. THEY SAY THE SUSPECTS THREATENED THE CASHIER WITH A RIFLE -TOOK SOME MONEY -AND DROVE AWAY IN A FORD EXPLORER. NO ONE WAS INJURED AND THERE WERE NO SHOTS FIRED.

THERE'S A TRIAL DATE SCHEDULED FOR THE END OF NEXT MONTH.

POLICE SAY BAMBOA DRIVING WHEN YAKAMA NATION POLICE TRIED TO PULL HIM OVER - BUT BAMBOA TOOK OFF -REACHING SPEEDS UP TO A HUNDRED MILES PER HOUR NEAR

WAPATO. HE NOW FACES ROBBERY AND ELUDING CHARGES. HE'LL BE BACK IN COURT IN A COUPLE OF WEEKS.

DESCRIPTION: FATAL SHOOTING On October 26, 2016 at about 2135 hours Yakima County Sheriff's deputies responded to the 700 block of Rosenkranz Rd regarding a gunshot victim. Upon arrival a 20 year old male from Tieton was deceased. Preliminary indications are that the victim died as a result of gunfire. Witnesses to the shooting stated that the victim and three other companions were traveling west in a vehicle on Rosenkranz Rd when another vehicle came up behind the victim vehicle and then passed the victim vehicle while simultaneously firing several rounds into the drivers side of the vehicle striking the victim. The suspect vehicle then fled the area. Witnesses were not clear as to the description of the suspect vehicle. A motive for the shooting is unclear. The deceased is identified as Trae Oyler who had recently moved to the Yakima area from out of state. Mr Oyler was actively involved in a local Christian youth ministry group and there are no indications that Mr Oyler has criminal or gang involvements. Next of kin have been notified. An autopsy will be scheduled in the coming days. The case remains under investigation by Yakima County Sheriff's detectives.

Law enforcement released the identity of the woman whose body was found near Clear Creek Fall east of White Pass Friday afternoon. The Yakima County Sheriff's Office identified Aurelia Galvan, 36, of Tacoma as a homicide victim. The suspect in custody for the murder of Galvan is her 38-year-old husband, who also from Tacoma. The next of kin have been notified. An autopsy will be scheduled in the coming days. The Yakima Sheriff's Office says no other suspects are being sought in the case. The case remains under investigation by Yakima County Sheriff's detectives and additional information will be released as it becomes available.

COURT PAPERS SAY THREE OTHER SUSPECTS GOT AWAY AFTER A HIGH SPEED CHASE WITH AUTHORITIES. POLICE SAY THIS SHOOTING IS POSSIBLY GANG RELATED. ACEVEDO IS FACING FIRST DEGREE ASSAULT CHARGES. POLICE SAY THE VICTIM IS 21-YEAR-OLD AARON PRIETO ... WHO'S STILL IN CRITICAL CONDITION IN A SEATTLE HOSPITAL.

DESCRIPTION: STABBING YAK At approximately 2:00 am Monday, November 7th, Yakima Police Officers were called to the area of North 20th Avenue and Jerome Avenue, in reference to a possible stabbing victim. When officers arrived they found a man lying on the ground, next to a parked vehicle, in the middle of the road with a stab wound. Life-saving efforts at the scene by officers and medics were unsuccessful, as the 26-year-old victim was pronounced deceased shortly after arriving at the hospital. A 24-year-old male suspect was taken into custody nearby. The investigation has revealed that the homicide is not gang related. This is the 12th homicide in Yakima this year. Yakima Police detectives continue to investigate. The name of the victim is withheld pending notification of next of kin.

THE BULLET THAT KILLED HARGETT ALSO ANOTHER WOMAN IN THE NECK. SHE WAS STANDING BEHIND HARGETT. DIMAS IS CHARGED WITH SECOND-DEGREE MURDER - ASSAULT AND FELON IN POSSESSION OF A FIREARM.

DESCRIPTION: WAPATO SHOOTINGA 74-year-old Native American man is dead after a shooting between two men at a home Monday night west of Wapato. Yakima County Coroner Jack Hawkins said the second man, a 56-year-old Native American man, was left in critical condition and taken to Harborview Medical Center due to his gunshot injuries. The shooting happened near Lateral Road and Sumac Street around 6:

30 p.m. Monday night according to Hawkins. Yakama Nation Police and agents with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) are investigating the incident. Hawkins will perform an autopsy on the 74-year-old man Tuesday afternoon. No information regarding the relationship between the two men was immediately available or the cause of the incident. This shooting makes the 19 homicide in Yakima County in 2016.

THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT SAYS THE VICTIM'S INFORMATION DID NOT MATCH UP AND THEY ARE STILL INVESTIGATING THE SITUATION.

Toppenish police are looking for the driver of a vehicle that struck an elderly man near S. Elm Street Monday night and then drove off. Police said a person driving a white Pontiac four-door vehicle hit an elderly man as he was crossing S. Elm Street around 5 p.m. with a walker. Police said witnesses said the driver of the vehicle stopped long enough to check on the man but then got back in his car and drove away. Authorities said the driver headed northbound on S. Elm Street after checking on the elderly man. The man that was hit suffered several injuries and was transported to Yakima Memorial Hospital and then later flown to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle said police. SOUTHRIDGE PRINCIPAL MOLLY HAMAKER-TEALS SENT OUT A LETTER TO PARENTS AND GUARDIANS TODAY TO LET THEM KNOW ABOUT THE INCIDENT. ACCORDING TO THE PRINCIPAL, THE STUDENTS MADE THE THREAT FOR A SHOOTING TO TAKE PLACE AT THE SCHOOL ON MONDAY IN A FACEBOOK CHAT ROOM WITH ANOTHER STUDENT. KENNEWICK POLICE INVESTIGATED THE REPORT AND FOUND THAT THE STUDENTS MADE THE THREAT AS A JOKE TO SCARE THE FIFTH STUDENT. THAT STUDENT REPORTED THE INCIDENT. POLICE SAY THAT NOTHING INDICATED IT TO BE A REAL THREAT. NO ARRESTS WERE MADE, BUT THE STUDENTS WERE PUT ON EMERGENCY EXPULSION PENDING A HEARING. CLASSES are scheduled to RESUME NORMALLY today.

The group had been geocaching, which involves hiding trinkets and other items to find by tracking the objects' GPS coordinates with smartphones, clues or compasses. Turner says they approached the vehicle and called 911 when they found the 52-year-old woman in the back seat. The victim, who has not been identified, was hospitalized for injuries to her head, neck and arm that were not life threatening. The crash remains under investigation.
