In the period from April 1, 2023, through June 30, 2023, radio stations

KJTH/KZTH/KXTH/KTHL/KIXO/KTHM/KTHF addressed several issues of public concern. Numerous public service announcements were made on behalf of various local non-profit organizations and churches. In the month of April, our staff attended and promoted seven different events in four days all around our listening areas. Many concerts happened that included artists like Lecrae, For King & Country, CAIN and Kari Jobe. We also were at the Fill The Stadium event at the University of Oklahoma that had over 20,000 people in attendance. Our staff also cheered on the Oklahoma City Marathon runners while our station played music for them as they ran by. Our mascot, Homie, attended the Oklahoma City Kids Marathon as well as he ran with the other mascots and handed out high fives. Also in the month of April, we promoted on air and on social media music with the message of Easter; which reminded listeners that it was a special week of programming due to the holiday. In the month of May, we held a one day fundraiser to help make up 2022's budget deficit. May's ministry partner was "in the gap okc". Their mission is to impact kids in the communities around us by bringing after school Bible programs to local public schools. We partnered with them by spreading the word and making awareness of this outreach organization that is located near the Oklahoma City Metro. In the month of June, our team and mascot Homie attended four Vacation Bible Schools; which had over 500 total kids in attendance. The team at each VBS spoke to the kids about the radio station and handed out promotional items to each child. We promoted on air and on social media a community event in Guthrie, OK, called Freedom Fest. Over 400 people were in attendance; we played the House FM radio over the speakers and spoke to many people who stopped by the booth. The House FM also passed along public information on severe and inclement weather. And, on the attached sheets, other issues are listed which were broadcast on the program "Focus on the Family". "Focus on the Family" airs each weekday from 5-5:30am.
