

Re: Public Awareness / Quarterly Issues

In the period from January 1, 2023, through March 31, 2023, radio stations KJTH/KZTH/KXTH/KTHL/KIXO/KTHM/KTHF addressed several issues of public concern. Numerous public service announcements were made on behalf of various local non-profit organizations and churches. In the month of January, we partnered with Seekers Church and helped sponsor a very special Jason Gray concert just for recovering addicts in Oklahoma City. Over 200 people attended this concert. We also continued with our Teacher Appreciation contest for the month of January. A teacher from Arkansas City, Kansas was randomly selected as our winner. They received a special house merchandise prize bag along with a \$100 Mardel giftcard. In February, we partnered with the Wichita Thunder Hockey team for a Faith & Family Night. Listeners of the station were eligible to win free tickets to the Faith & Family Night by calling into Kevin and Amy's Morning show, entering into our text giveaway, or by commenting on our social media page. One lucky winner also was selected to win a customized House hockey jersey along with some cool House FM merchandise. Our ministry partner for the month of February was Branch 15. We helped spread awareness of this ministry on air and on social media to the communities around us. In March, we kicked off our annual Spring Fundraiser to raise the funds necessary to help meet our 2023 non-profit budget. We partnered with The Homeless Alliance during our Spring Fundraiser and with the help of our donors, we were able to donate almost 1,000 meals to help feed the homeless in Oklahoma City. Also in the month of March, we had a social media contest called "Music of March" where listeners went to our Facebook and Instagram page and voted for their favorite artist/band. There were 32 Christian artists listed to vote for and listeners took advantage of this contest. We had over 3,000 votes for this contest. Our team went to several different outreach and promotional events this month in many different parts of the state. Those events included Winter Jam in Oklahoma City/Tulsa/Wichita, Casting Crowns and We Are Messengers concert in Enid, Matthew West concert in Bethany, Toby Mac concert in Tulsa, Women of Compassion an Oklahoma Baptist Homes for Children event in Oklahoma City, and OKC Dream Center Gala in Oklahoma City. The House FM also passed along public information on severe and inclement weather. And, on the attached sheets, other issues are listed which were broadcast on the program "Focus on the Family". "Focus on the Family" airs each weekday from 5-5:30am.

Title Reaching Across Cultural Divides I-II

Description Racial disharmony is tearing communities apart, both inside and outside the Church. But Jesus is the great reconciler, and we too are called by God to build bridges, cross cultural lines, and model diversity in every area of our lives.
