55+ Driver Improvement Program

This Driver Improvement Program is put on by the Minnesota Highway Safety Research Center through St. Cloud State University. You can check out their website at www.mnsafetycenter.org. It is an awareness-level driver safety program that is primarily intended for the 55+ age population. However, many/most of the concepts and information provided may be applicable to drivers of all ages. These courses will give participants a better understanding of vehicle and traffic safety, new technology, physical changes and increased driving risks as we age, changes to laws and the decisions drivers can make to be safer on our roadways. The presenter will provide you with information in both lecture and video format that can be discussed with other class participants.

This program is an approved Accident Prevention course by the MN Department of Public Safety. Participants who complete this course every 3 years are eligible for a 10% discount on their personal automobile insurance premium.


**THERE WILL BE A MEMORIAL PROGRAM TO HONOR THE SERVICE MEN AND

I was attached to the 836th hospital squadron . I joined the 37th medical group for a 90 day TDY South East Asia. Upon returning volunteered for Howard AFB Central America . Discharged in 1968 . Worked for Central Du Page Hospital Chicago Il. as head of the hematology department. Then moved back to Minnesota to work for the state , working with adolescents with mental health problems . Later in my career , I managed a group home for schizophrenics.
