THERE WAS LITTLE CROSS EXAMINATION FROM THE DEFENSE TODAY. THEIR CASE COMES DOWN TO WHETHER THEY CAN CONVINCe JURORS TO ACQUIT MONFORT ON THE REASON OF INSANITY

IF CONVICTED, HE COULD FACE THE DEATH PENALTY.

DURING THE TRIAL, PROSECUTORS PLAYED MCENROE'S TAPED CONFESSION TO THE JURY.
WHEN ASKED WHY THE KIDS WERE KILLED, PROSECUTORS SAY IT WAS BECAUSE MCENROE DIDN'T WANT TO LEAVE ANY WITNESSES.

SYMPTOMS OF THE MEASLES INCLUDE A HIGH FEVER OF 104 DEGREES OR MORE A COUGH, RUNNY NOSE RED WATERY EYES AND A RASH THAT BREAKS OUT 3 TO 5 DAYS AFTER THE SYMPTOMS BEGIN..

THIS... AFTER TWO CONFIRMED MEASLES CASES IN THE AREA. FIRST A 52 YR OLD MAN WHO WAS HOSPITALIZED FEB 1ST AND HAS SINCE RECOVERED... THEN A 5 YEAR OLD GIRL WHO ATTENDS KINDERGARTEN HERE AT OLYMPIC CHRISTIAN SCHOOL WHILE THE LITTLE GIRL IS QUARANTINED AT HER HOME.. THE SCHOOL SAYS ANY STUDENTS WHO CAN'T PROVE IMMUNITY TO MEASLES ARE NOT ALLOWED TO COME BACK UNTIL FEBRUARY 27TH.

KEEP IN MIND- ALLERGENS IN THE ENVIRONMENT DO NOT TRIGGER ANAPHALAXIS.

BUT IF YOU KNOW YOU HAVE A SEVERE ALLERGY TO SOMETHING... LIKE A FOOD, OR MEDICATION... DO YOUR BEST TO AVOID IT.
