Show Title: Film Thing

Duration: 1 Hour

Date: September 28th, 2023

Start Time: 7:00 P.M.

The hosts discussed a recent film: “Theater Camp”, a film about a high school theater camp in upstate New York. They informed our listeners about local theaters hosting the release after discussing the film’s content, and touched on the implications of the film being available on streaming only two weeks after its theatrical release.

The hosts discussed gentrification in Sapelo Island, Georgia, specifically the displacement caused in the Hog Hammock Community. They compared the state of affairs in the relationships between the island's Geechee Residents and the Heritage Authority to historic moves by the Georgia House that have promoted gentrification in Atlanta and Athens.

The hosts informed our listeners that sixty-one people have been indicted in Georgia on racketeering charges related to the "Cop City" protests, including at least one Athens resident. They discussed the legal implications of the indictment as well as the previous charges of domestic terrorism issued against arrested attendees of the "Stop Cop City Music Festival" held in Weelaunee Forest, several of which were Athens residents.

National Issues
