Dear Mr. Gaston:

Pursuant to the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), this is to notify you that WNET, licensee of television station WLIW(TV), Garden City, New York, Facility ID Number 38336 (the "Station"), hereby elects to invoke its rights to have the Station's signal carried on your system or systems. This election of mandatory carriage covers the period from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017.

WNET elects to have WLIW(TV) carried on Channel 21 on your system(s). WLIW(TV) is a qualified local noncommercial educational television station for purposes of the FCC's mandatory carriage rules. Therefore the Station is entitled to carriage on each cable system whose principal headend is located within 80.45 km of Garden City, New York's reference point, as defined in the FCC rules, and on each cable system whose principal headend is located within WLIW(TV)'s noise limited contour.

This election does not affect the carriage of the Station, or any or all of its channels, by your system(s) pursuant to any existing retransmission agreement related to your system(s) that covers the Station or to which WNET (formerly known as WNET.ORG or Educational Broadcasting Corporation), is a party.
