We dedicate a minimum of five hours of programming weekly, specifically and exclusively, to the communities we serve, with on air interviews discussing a vast array of topics, events, concerns, and conversations relevant to the Dartmouth-Lake Sunapee Region.

The below list contains various interviews WNTK Talk Radio had conducted representing local issues of interest. This list does not represent an exhaustive array of the total accumulation of quarterly issued discussed, yet these segments simultaneously provide examples of the various interview topics WNTK covers on a consistent and daily basis.

Issue: Public Interest

Broadcast: April 17th 2023 Time: 9 AM - 10 AM

Duration: 1 Hour

On Daytrip Destinations, Ashlee Rowley and Matt Cross discuss various topics, including the anniversary of the Claremont Community Center and activities coming up for the public to attend, including a plant seminar. Also an Easter Egg event at Arrowhead Mountain, a softball tournament, Claremont youth baseball and softball, granite state track and field, rental room, pool, aerobics room, etc.

Broadcast: April 24th 2023 Time: 9 AM - 10 AM

Duration: 1 Hour

On Daytrip Destinations, Ashlee Rowley and Matt Cross discuss various topics, including several self health wellness tips to practice. This week specifically they discuss social wellness, including getting away with friends, giving yourself personal time to decompress, random acts of kindness, volunteering at non profits, sleep health and routines, and more. Also discussed is the upcoming Sunapee Farmers Market, and details around the hour changes for 2023, launching May 27th and running through Labor Day Weekend.

Broadcast: May 5th 2023 Time: 9 AM - 10 AM

Duration: 1 Hour

On Daytrip Destinations, Ashlee Rowley and Matt Cross discuss various topics, including the upcoming Tri Chamber of Commerce business after hours event for the Claremont, Newport and Lake Sunapee Region chambers. It's the first business after hours for the three combined chambers, and available to attend for both members of the chambers as well as non members. Also discussed is the New London Barn Playhouse and a recap of their upcoming season's performances/shows.

Issue: Public Interest


Broadcast June 9th, 2023 Time: 9 AM - 10 AM
