The Mammoth Screen Theatre shows 3D movies that explore worlds and environments as never seen before.

With more than 400 interactive opportunities to quench curious minds, the Museum of Natural Curiosity features everything from the Rainforest to Water Works to the Discovery Garden and the town of Kidopolis.

Thanksgiving Point offers more than experiences. It is the perfect gathering place for events, meetings, and celebrations. Named the Best in State for "Best Event/Performance Venue" every year since 2013, it offers both indoor and outdoor facilities to accommodate groups of all sizes.

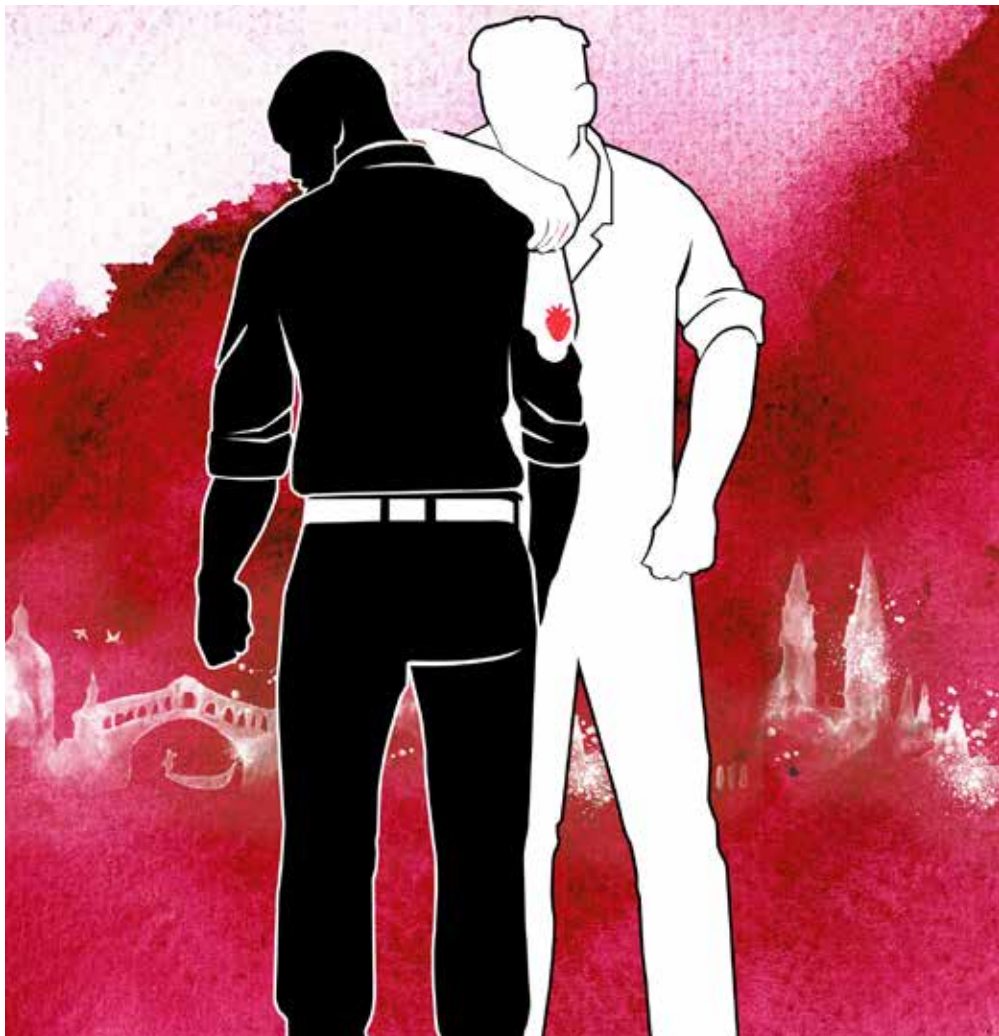
