

## UNDERWRITER PROFILE



Salt Lake County Aging & Adult Services offers a wide variety of programs that are designed to meet the needs of a diverse population of older adults and those who care for them. From seniors who are thriving and active in the community to those struggling to meet their basic needs, programs are available to support and assist those who need it.

Whether looking for the right agency, connecting with chore services like yard work or house cleaning, or community organizations searching for training on the needs of aging adults, Salt Lake County Aging & Adult Services' Outreach Program is the perfect first step to receive information and connect people with appropriate services.

Based on eligibility, there are many programs available to support older adults. Some services include Meals on Wheels that delivers hot midday meals to frail and isolated adults, and Rides for Wellness provides transportation to vital medical appointments for those age 60 and older with no other means of transportation.

The Salt Lake County Aging & Adult Services also connects those who wish to volunteer. Participants can choose from more than 70 organizations that need volunteer support, including Meals on Wheels, Rides for Wellness, Senior Centers, the Senior Companion Program, and more. Opportunities to be a foster grandparent for at-risk children, volunteering as a senior companion for isolated older adults living at home, or serving at a local school are some of the many ways that senior volunteers can use their skills and experiences to learn something new and meet new people.

There are also programs to support and assist unpaid caregivers who are the primary support for their spouse, friend, or neighbor. From information and free classes to support groups and limited respite services, this program helps those who are tirelessly helping loved ones.

The Community Care Transitions Program provides services to help older adults remain at home in a safe environment. Those who are eligible receive case management and other support including homemaking, personal care, shopping, meal preparation, medical equipment, and more.

No matter what the needs, Salt Lake County Aging & Adult Services is available to help and support the community. They are also proud to support and underwrite the programs on KUED.
