My take-away was realizing how many different viewpoints and factors are involved in whatever discussion comes next. I am impressed how producer Nancy Green made clear the situation in the one-hour documentary premiering on Monday, November 12 at 8:00 p.m. on Channel 7.1. As a Utahn, you should not miss it.

Also in the news at KUED are our recent Emmy awards garnered at the Rocky Mountain Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences event in Phoenix. Nominees are submitted by producing stations and evaluated by other chapters across the country. UNDERWRITER PROFILE


