

PBS' **Summer of Adventure** continues this month with two new series – one exploring the vast Australian outback and one that journeys through Mexico.

Outback, airing Wednesdays, August 1-15 at 7:00 p.m., takes a year-long journey with the people and animals of the Kimberley region in the northern part of western Australia – an expansive, rugged, and remote wilderness bursting with character.

Wonders of Mexico, airing the same Wednesday nights at 8:00 p.m., travels through the tropical forests of the Maya, south along Mexico's mountain spine, and across the deserts of Northern Mexico to discover amazing wildlife and culture.


