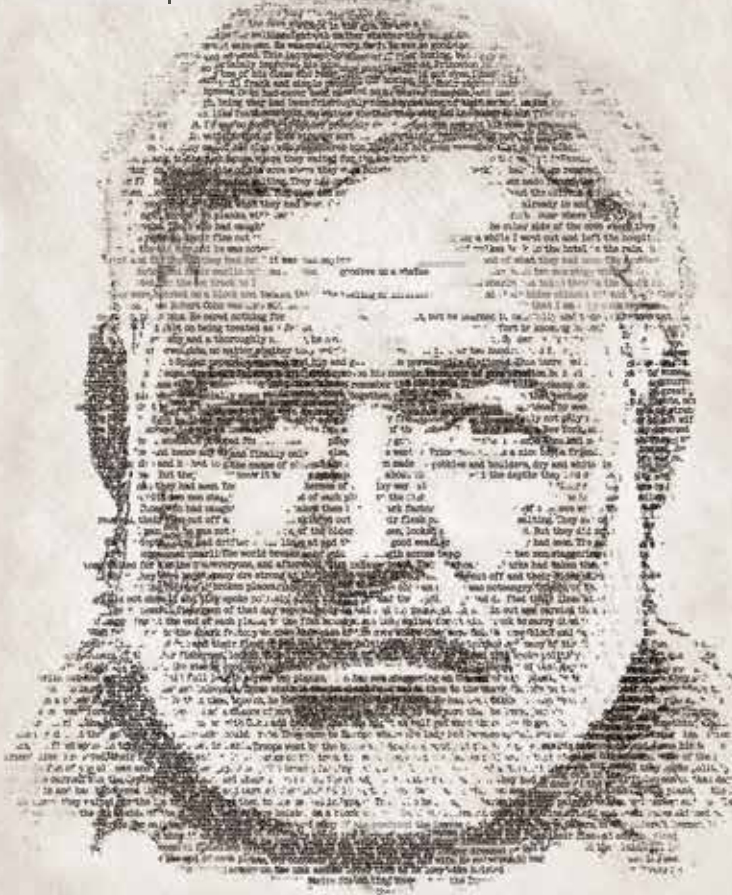

Tranquil. Inspiring. Fun!

These are just some of the words people use to describe the new exhibits and botanical gardens at Tracy Aviary.

Most Utahns have been to Tracy Aviary in Liberty Park at some point in their lives. But over the last decade, more than \$35 million in renovations and new exhibits have transformed the Aviary to educate and inspire a new generation of visitors.

One example is Treasures of the Rainforest, an indoor exhibit featuring the sights and sounds of an authentic tropical locale. Visitors come face to face with a variety of exotic birds like the nearly extinct Guam kingfisher — a bird that Tracy Aviary is helping to protect so that its population can be restored.

Expedition Kea features the world's only alpine parrot, an endangered bird known for its natural curiosity, intelligence, and fun-to-watch antics. The accessible and mostly flat grounds at the Aviary make it easy to enjoy keas and all the birds — from Andy the Andean condor to the beloved flamingos — in about the time it takes to watch a movie.

While education has always been central to Tracy Aviary's mission, the organization has become a respected leader in environmental education and conservation. Focusing on key local habitats and pressing regional conservation issues, the Aviary's goals are to gather new information about local avian ecology, inform habitat restoration and stewardship, and engage a diverse community in scientific data collection.

The Community Science Program involves members of the public to help scientists collect and analyze data. And with a number of local science projects throughout the state, no matter where you are, you can help protect local wild birds and their habitats. Tracy Aviary relies on the support of individuals and organizations to continue this important work. More information can be found at tracyaviary.org.
