UTAH EDUCATION NETWORK

The Utah Education Network (UEN) is a nationally recognized innovator in broadband and broadcast delivery of educational services for educators and students in Utah's K-12 schools, technical colleges, institutions of higher education, and public libraries. UEN links more than 880,000 students and 77,000 educators and staff statewide, and operates in partnership with the Utah State Board of Education and Utah System of Higher Education.

UEN facilitates interactive video conferencing and provides instructional support services and network access to students, parents, educators, and local communities across the state. UEN's networking services include broadband and digital TV networks, internet access, and filtering and secure monitoring. UEN's support services help users engage with UEN infrastructure and hosting, including teachers, faculty, librarians, and regional support centers.

UEN-TV, the educational television arm of UEN, provides four digital broadcast channels. Channel 9 features educational programming, including learning programs aimed at K-12 students, college distance education telecourses, and teacher development programs. UEN-TV broadcasts programming from Utah Instructional Television (ITV) on weekdays, and features telecourses from Salt Lake Community College, Utah Valley University, and The University of Utah in its overnight programming. Digital channel 9.3, FNX, offers Native American programming, and digital channel 9.4, NHK World-Japan, airs the latest news from Japan and Asia, covering politics, economy, technology, culture, and more.

To meet the needs of distance learning in the times of COVID-19, UEN provides various resources for distance education, such as interactive field trips, training resources, Zoom and WebEx video conferencing technology, and more. UEN also operates eMedia, a curated digital library of educational resources created specifically for Utah learners.

Since 1989, UEN has connected more than 658,000 thousand K-12 students, more than 225,000 higher education students, and more than 77,000 educators and staff from pre-school through college with the vital educational services they need to succeed.
