Manager's Memo

The KUED engineering department has been hard at work installing nearly 500 translators in rural Utah. We're racing against the calendar as the weather gets cooler and winter is just around the corner. Translators are located on mountain tops where the snow builds up in late fall. We're thankful to T-Mobile for funding the purchase of the translators, budgeted at around \$7 million, assuring that most of Utah will continue to receive television signals.

KUED was nominated for seven Emmy awards for its local programming. **Search & Rescue**, **On the Spectrum, Homeless at the End, A Home of Their Own, Lagoon: Rock and Rollercoasters**, local program promotions, and a promo for KUED's 60th Anniversary are all up for awards, competing with regional commercial stations.

Now that KUED broadcasts four channels – KUED 7.1, our main channel; WORLD, Channel 7.2; PBS Kid's 24/7, Channel 7.3; and CREATE, Channel 7.4 – our program guide is due for an update. We're planning to make changes after the first of the year to reflect a better picture of what's on each channel and to make it easier for you to find your favorite programs. Along with **KUED Passport**, access to KUED programming will be easier than ever.


