Section I. Issues

The stations have identified the following topics as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- A. Cannabis Climate: Recreational cannabis legalization and the fast-evolving world of cryptocurrency are giving some Yakima Valley entrepreneurs economic opportunities. The effects from the so-called war on drugs continues to hinder economic progress for certain communities of color.
- B. **Economy:** The above-average default rate of student loans for some Yakima Valley college students is preventing many young adults and middle-aged residents from expanding their personal wealth.
- C. **Climate Change:** Carbon emissions, greenhouse gases, and dwindling levels of water reservoirs are speeding up global warming. Transitioning to an Earth-friendly diet and decreasing food waste are both ways families can combat the global plastic crisis.
- D. Health/Healthcare: The closure of Astria Regional Hospital in 2020 has put extra burdens on existing medical staff and medical provider recruitment. Yakima Memorial Hospital has pivoted to hiring doctors and specialists from outside the region, including neurologists, in order to provide quality care during the coronavirus pandemic.
- E. **Labor:** Black Authors discuss why racial bias still exists in America from their perspectives and how we can eradicate systemic racism in our Yakima Valley communities.
- F. **Senior Care:** The Yakima County population is estimated at slightly over 250,000 people, according to the 2019 U.S. Census. Fourteen percent of this population are seniors ages 65 years and older. High employee turnover at nursing home facilities on an average decrease of 74% per year means there is soon going to not be enough new workers entering the caregiving field. What is causing this alarming career downward spiral?
