Section I. Issues

The stations have identified the following topics as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- A. **Cannabis Legalization:** Cannabis legalization in Washington state created a billion-dollar industry. There were over 22,500 cannabis jobs in the state in 2022. A new law allows residents to grow up to 6 cannabis plants at home or 15 for medical use. Humans have used cannabis for thousands of years, but it was banned in the US due to racism and xenophobia.
- B. **Climate Change:** Washington state has an unofficial 5th weather season, Wildfire Season. This year, our state had 1,515 local wildfires, which is nearly double the amount we had in 2022. Wildfires from Canada also continue to threaten our air quality in Washington. Human-caused climate change has increased the likelihood of wildfire season in our region.
- C. Culture: Many local residents have fallen prey to the latest batch of misinformation from conspiracy theory groups. Anti-government groups, like Q-Anon, Proud Boys, Oath Keepers, and other anti-government and militia groups are growing exponentially in number within Washington state. Modern social media and artificial intelligence are being widely used to fuel these alternative narratives.
- D. **Environment:** As solar energy installation costs decrease in Washington state, more families and businesses are taking advantage of this alternate energy source. Around 9% of the population is using solar panels. Consumers can recycle the panels to make solar energy truly sustainable without clogging up landfills with toxic chemicals.
- E. **Mental Health:** Protecting one's mental health in a world filled with fitting in, achieving good grades, and getting high test scores continues to be a difficult challenge for youth residing in Washington state. A recent report stated A 2021 survey found that nearly 60% of Washington high school students reported feeling sad or depressed in the past year. Parents should remember to prepare kids to gain life skills, like setting good habits and cultivating independence now before they become adults.
- F. **Technology:** Washington state is the headquarters home to at least 3 major companies (Microsoft, Google, and Amazon) that are ushering in ChatGPT to the masses. Despite the initial reluctance to embrace generative AI programming and software, many employees in Central Washington have begun utilizing this new technology in fields like education, music composition, digital journalism, retail sales, customer interaction, medical fields, and more. We can use ChatGPT to rethink the future and advance our industries to reduce some of the menial job tasks we take for granted.
