January 1, 2022 – March 30, 2022

Friday January 7, 2022 – 9am – 30 mins. - The Indie News Hour – Issues addressed: The impending announcement of a new superintendent at the Nauset Regional School District; the increase in COVID cases in schools following the winter break and the measures being taken to prevent the spread of the virus in local schools.

Friday January 14, 2022 – 9am – 30 mins. - The Indie News Hour – Issues addressed: affordable housing in Provincetown and the proposed development at the former VFW site; affordable housing in Wellfleet and a proposal to allow affordable housing to be built on formerly unbuildable lots;

Friday January 28, 2022 – 9am – 30 mins. - The Indie News Hour – Issues addressed: finalists for the superintendent job at Nauset Regional School District; the retirement of the Cape & Islands District Attorney and the candidates to replace him.

Friday February 4, 2022 – 9am – 30 mins. - The Indie News Hour – Issues addressed: the naming of the new Nauset Regional School District; the permitting of new development at Willy's Gym in Eastham after a long process; the implementation of a year-round resident property tax exemption in Eastham

Friday February 11, 2022 – 9am – 30 mins. - The Indie News Hour – Issues addressed: the aftermath of the recent blizzard and the town response; the moving of a house in Truro that was overhanging the dune after the storm;

Friday February 18, 2022 – 9am – 30 mins. - The Indie News Hour – Issues addressed: the latest developments at the Truro Motor Inn – including alleged unsafe living conditions and the efforts to relocate residents; the settlement of a court case brought by Truro residents against the affordable housing development known as The Cloverleaf

Friday February 25, 2022 – 9am – 30 mins. - The Indie News Hour – Issues addressed: the Plymouth nuclear power plant and its plan to dump radioactive water into Cape Cod Bay; the unpermitted destruction of an historic home in Eastham; the sale of a Truro property that includes more than 20 residential units and a restaurant

Friday March 4 2022 – 9am – 30 mins. - The Indie News Hour – Issues addressed: the need to install fire suppression at Wellfleet elementary; the preparations for Eastham town meeting and the budget requests for the various departments
