Children will learn about the resources of the oceans and how protection of the oceans is necessary to present and future generations. The show teaches biological topics and aims to enrich children's lives by making them aware of future generations and the role they play now, with the biggest ecosystem on earth – the oceans. Each episode provides information related to a specific topic and gives an educational approach to understand the topic related to the entire ecosystem of the earth. Aqua Kids provides children with a way to learn about the diversity of marine animals around the world and the importance of preserving their fragile aquatic habitats. Through the use of hands-on collaboration between kids and science researchers and educators, Aqua Kids encourages children to take an active role in protecting the future of their communities and the world.

Dragonfly TV is a weekly half-hour science television series for children ages 13 to 16.
