The series features role models from professional sports and the entertainment industry. Dooley, a friendly alien who has landed in a backyard on Earth, explores the planet with the children of the neighborhood as his guides. The show is designed to teach moral values and educational basics.



Scuba Bob

Scuba Bob has a passion for the underwater world and is motivated to help people have his same passion by turning the viewer's living rooms into a portal to the many mysteries and adventures offered by this liquid world. With the help of a seasoned crew, Scuba Bob's Ocean Quest is a program that uses underwater video to show exotic destinations that have a connection with conservation topics. Each episode reveals exciting adventures and encounters like coral spawning, dolphins, sharks and those caring for critical habitats. Each show informs with critical facts about ocean conservation.

Animal Rescue

Animal Rescue serves the educational and informational needs of children 13 to 16 years of age with its program content, including safety tips and information about various animals and their habitats. The programs also show real life in-the-field experiences of professional and ordinary people taking care of, treating, and helping various animals, as well as exhibiting good social responsibility and promotion of strong personal and community values.

Scaly Adventures

Scaly Adventures is an adventure series that profiles exotic animals and experts who work to conserve and protect them. The passion of the Scaly Adventures Crew is to educate children while encouraging them to reach for the stars and follow their dreams.

Dog Tales

Dog Tales serves the educational and informational needs of children 13 to 16 years of age with its program content, including dog safety and care tips, as well as lessons on the responsibility of owning a dog. The show also provides informative segments on various dog breeds and showcases various veterinary experts explaining different issues affecting canines.

Think Big

Think Big serves the educational and informational needs of children 13 to 16 years of age with its program content, including the importance of having a working knowledge of math, science, and physics. The series shows children actively solving problems using scientific principles, combining skill and creativity. The series also demonstrates real-world applications for math, science and engineering, proving that the physical sciences can be useful, challenging and fun. Each episode presents and invent-off challenge, where teenage teams must invent a machine designed to perform a specific task in a limited amount of time, promoting creative thinking and practical skills.
