ISSUES COVERED INCLUDE: FAMILY RELATIONSHIPS, RACE RELATIONS, WOMENS' ISSUES, HEALTH, COMMUNITY VENTURES AND CO-OPS; TEENAGE ISSUES; AS WELL AS FINANCIAL ADVICE, ADULT EDUCATION, SUBSTANCE ABUSE - PREVENTION - RECOVERY; SOUP KITCHENS, HOMELESS MINISTRIES, AND HELP FOR IMPOVERISHED PEOPLE. THE HOURS THAT THE PROGRAM IS AIRED HAS SHOWN TO BE AN IDEAL TIME TO HELP THE LONELY, THE HURTING, THOSE THAT ARE DISTRESSED, DEJECTED AND STRUGGLING.

I'M SURE THAT THERE ARE MANY OTHER CATEGORIES I HAVE FAILED TO MENTION, AS ON CERTAIN OCCASIONS, THE HOST WILL SELECT A SPECIFIC THEME FOR THAT NIGHT.
